

YACHT CHARTERS IN GREECE. REGULATIONS FOR EEC MEMBERS

Members of EEC can since 2003 own & operate a yacht charter business in Greece by registering the company and the boats under the Greek flag or operate under their own country flag.

Registration under the Greek flag.

- Registration of the person or company with the Greek Tax office and register as a business. You can register as a private person or as a company.
- Appoint a Greek representative to administer the company or the boat and deal with the Greek authorities for all matters of the company and the boat/s and be responsible for the VAT payments.
- Appoint an auditor/bookkeeper to keep the books of the person/company.
- Boats will go through the registration procedures and tests the same as applied for the Greek boats.

Registration of the company and boats under foreign flag

The boat/s must be registered as commercial/charter boats in their own country. A letter/certificate from the local authority is required.

- Registration of the person or company with the Greek Tax office and register as a business. You can register as a private person or as a company.
- Appoint a Greek representative to administer the company or the boat and deal with the Greek authorities for all matters of the company and the boat/s and be responsible for the VAT payments.
- Appoint an auditor/bookkeeper to keep the books of the person/company.
- Boats will be inspected by an appointed surveyor and a certificate of sea worthiness will be obtained.
- Boats and equipment must comply as per the Greek boats.
